In general, individuals planning international travel should consult with the professionals at Integ▼Net's Travelers' Health Clinic six weeks before departure.

Each itinerary will be individually cross-checked to provide the latest information available for protection from the World Health Organization and Centers for Disease Control.

Personalized Travel Package

Each client will be provided with a personalized travel package for a healthy, safe trip to include:

- Travel consultation
- Advice on preventing illness while traveling
- Education on safety concerns of food, drink and recreational activities
- Determination of current required and recommended immunizations based on itinerary, personal history of immunizations and planned activities of travel
- Official International Certificate of Vaccination
- Traveler's report of geography and climate, country specific diseases and travel advisories on the social/political environment
- U.S. Embassy locations with telephone and fax numbers
